Desirable spaces Harborview penthouse comes with a million-dollar view 🏠



With a bird's-eye view of Baltimore's **Inner Harbor** and beyond, penthouse 1B is located on levels 24 and 25 of the high-rise condominium at 100 Harborview Drive. This two-story residence (one of only two in the building) is on the market for \$1.7 million.

"The views are breathtaking, with walls of windows on its north and south sides," said listing agent and realtor Bill Ganz of Ganz Exclusive Real Estate. "This is a palace in the sky."

The four-bedroom, 4 1/2-bath unit does have a palatial feel, with marble flooring in the living room, dining room and family room. The flooring continues in the foyer, which features a winding, decorative metal staircase to the second level. There, an open, wrap-around hallway looks down at the family room and out to city and water vistas that surround the 27-story building.

The four carpeted bedrooms have stellar views, as well.

The kitchen, with ceramic tiling, gleams with its stainless-steel appliances, which include a Sub-Zero refrigerator, a Dacor range, a Miele dishwasher, a metal-topped breakfast bar and a butler's pantry with wine storage.
